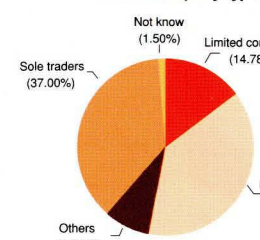

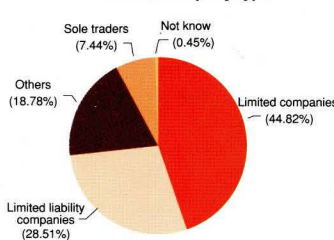

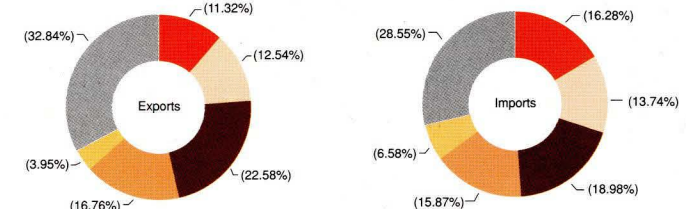


Employees by legal status/company type

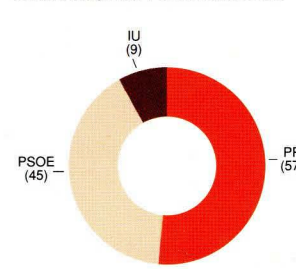

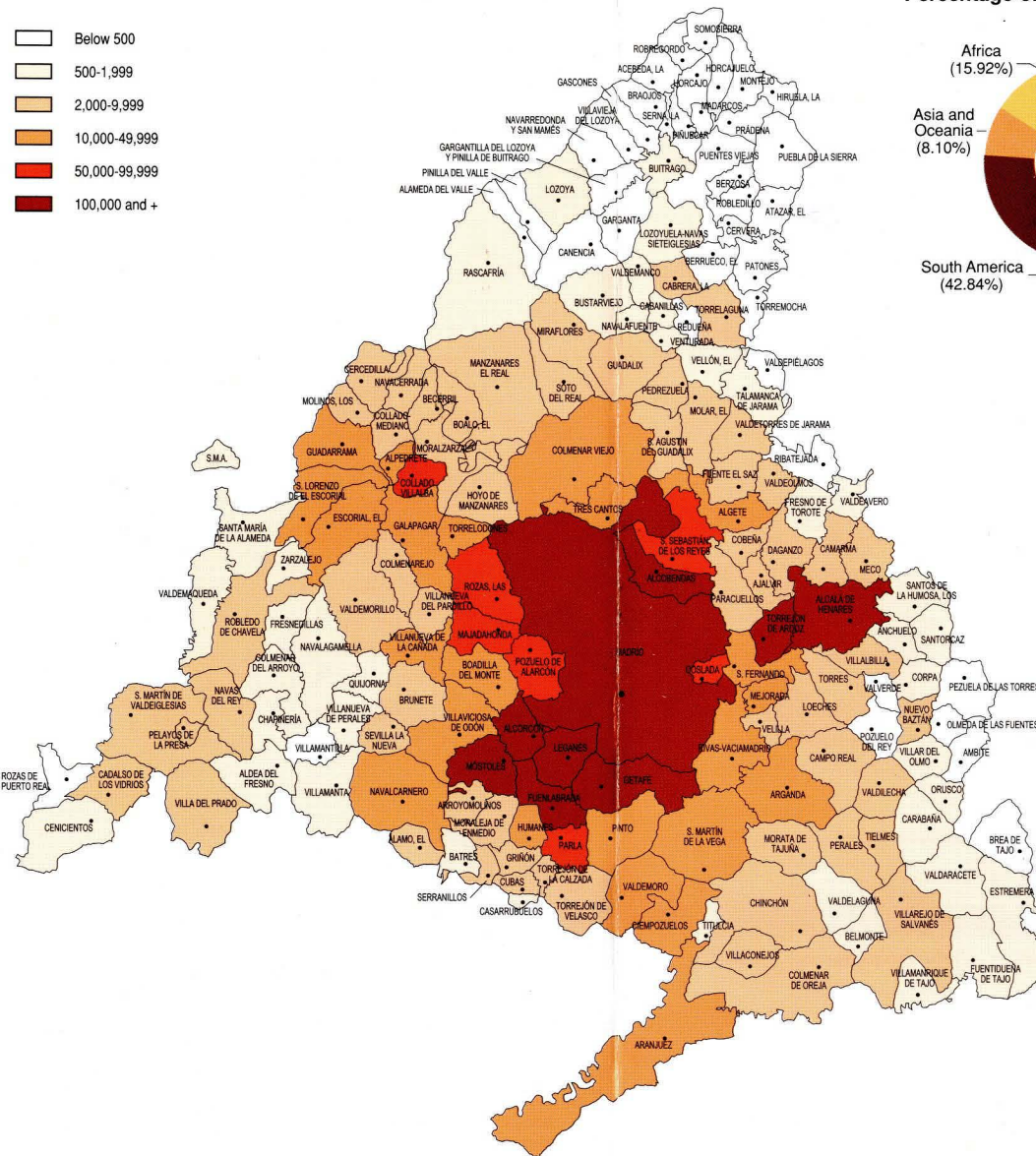

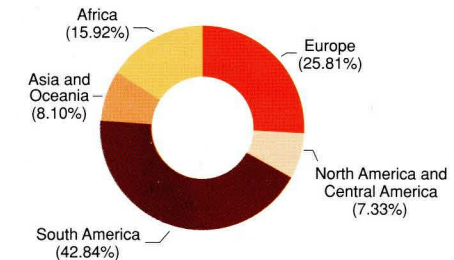

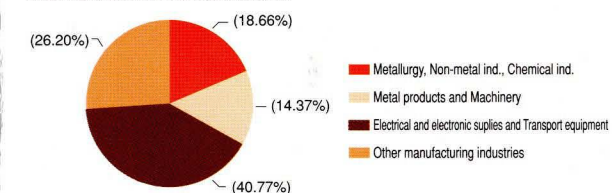
